## Ages 3-12 Contest Information

A belt buckle, banner & tiara will be awarded to the winner. Trophies will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup> runner-up, 2<sup>nd</sup> runner-up and participants in each division. Contestants will be required to wear western attire at all times (hat, boots, belt, etc.). Contestants should arrive to the interview session dressed in a solid color button up shirt with a collar, jeans, boots, hat and belt. No dress tops, embellishments or leather dress items will be allowed and will result in a disqualification of contestant. (This will be strictly enforced!) The objective of this is to instill basic fundamentals of rodeo queen knowledge (Interviewing & Social Skills) This also places direct emphasis on the contestant's personality, appearance and poise. The end goal is to have fun, learn and promote rodeo and its sponsors. You are not expected to spend lots of money on clothing. Contestants for the Limestone Sheriff's Rodeo Queen Pageant do not have to be residents of Limestone County or the State of Alabama.
